MSC transports a range of commodities – key contributors to national and regional GDP such as coffee, cocoa, tea and cotton – connecting African farmers and small enterprises to markets around the world. Our support for the Ghanaian cocoa trade has been recognized by the

Ghana Cocoa Board's Shipping Line of the Year award. We recognize our enabling role to support access to essential goods for communities and secure humanitarian supply chains across the African continent.

At MSC we believe we have a role to play in building more inclusive societies, fostering economic growth, transferring technical knowledge and empowering tomorrow's workforce with the skills needed to navigate the energy transition and overcome supply chain disruptions. In South Africa, we have conducted a leadership programme for upskilling disadvantaged young people, providing qualifications in international trade, clearing and freight forwarding and shipping and employing many graduates of the programme.

For communities impacted by instability, MSC contributes to their economic development by boosting employment and enhancing the business capacity of local enterprises. In Mozambique, we have been working in close collaboration with government, academia and other local partners to support capacity development in transport and logistics to a former competitor, as well as providing employment and training opportunities as part of preparing our future talent pipeline for MSC offices, warehouses and depots across the country.

OUR PARTNERS AND PROGRAMMES IN AFRICA

UNICEF

Since 2019, we’ve partnered with UNICEF on the “Plastic Waste Goes to School” programme in the Ivory Coast. We’re supporting children’s education and improving women’s employment by transforming plastic waste into innovative low-cost bricks for modern classrooms, all while fostering a women-empowering recycling market. To date, the programme has trained 188 women who are organized in a formal association, recycled around 616,000 kg of plastic waste and completed 112 modern classrooms, enabling 6,224 children to gain access to education.



MERCY SHIPS

In December 2021, we celebrated ten years of partnership with Mercy Ships, bringing life-changing hope and healing to thousands in Africa. During the partnership, 19,740 surgeries, 218,100 dental procedures and medical training for 15,150 participants have been performed.



MSC MEDITERRANEAN SHIPPING COMPANY

MSC has developed a strong presence in Africa with a network of agencies in more than 40 countries, each of them with responsibility for commercial and operational activities in their respective territories.

Over the past five decades, our local teams have accumulated both experience and expertise in handling all types of goods, along with a comprehensive knowledge of global port operations. That's why we've become the trusted transportation partner of so many of the world's most prestigious companies, delivering countless cargoes and commodities with the utmost care.

As a major partner to companies across Africa, MSC continues to invest in the continent's infrastructure, connecting it to the world. Lomé Container Terminal (LCT), MSC's hub for West Africa at the port of Lomé in Togo,

offers direct services from Asia and Europe, serving also the landlocked countries of Mali, Niger and Burkina Faso and the northern areas of Nigeria. In May 2017, MSC and San Pedro Port signed a 35-year concession agreement for the expansion of the San Pedro Container Terminal (TCSP). In December 2022, MSC's acquisition of Bollore Africa Logistics SAS and its affiliates ("Bollore Africa Logistics Group") highlighted the long-term commitment of MSC to invest in African supply chains and infrastructure, supporting the needs of clients of both businesses. MSC will operate Bollore Africa Logistics Group as an autonomous entity with its portfolio of diversified partners, under the new AGL (Africa Global Logistics) brand.

In addition, we continue to make significant investments in West Africa to offer multimodal transportation solutions that are optimized, safe and sustainable by road and rail.

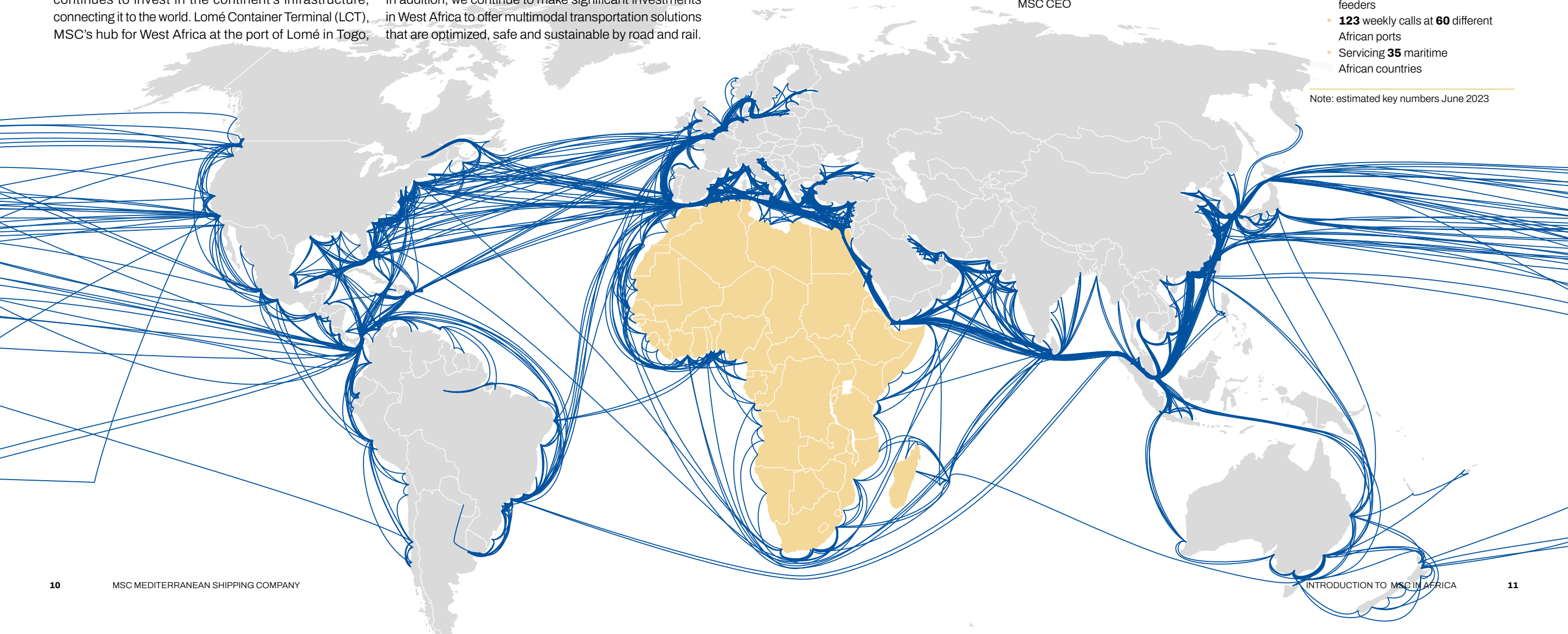

SHIPPING SOLUTIONS

Trade Services

MSC's trade managers have an in-depth understanding of individual overseas markets and the dynamics of specific trades. Our experts offer market-specific, local advice on factors affecting the transit of any type of cargo. These may include:

- Terminal conditions
- Local or overseas transport infrastructure
- Berthing delays or congestion
- Local or overseas regulatory and political changes
- Relevant customs procedures

Dry Cargo

MSC provides equipment, know-how and experience to move commodities such as paper, white goods and scrap metals but also to safely handle other types of cargo: hazardous, food-grade, rare and precious.

Reefer Cargo

MSC owns one of the largest reefer container fleets in the world and offers unrivalled customer care and expertise in the global transport of refrigerated cargo (e.g., fresh fruit, meat products, seafood, pharmaceuticals and confectionery).

Perishable goods require precise temperature control to maintain their quality all the way to their final destination. At MSC, we follow highly standardized control procedures to optimize the cooling process. These include Cold Treatment (CT) and Controlled Atmosphere (CA).

Project Cargo

We provide global out-of-gauge and breakbulk solutions. As experts in the transportation of oversized cargo, we have access to specialized equipment and handling facilities such as container lift trailers, floating cranes and cargo securing solutions.

Cross Trading

When cargo is moved between an origin and destination without it entering the country where the shipper is registered, it is commonly referred to as cross trade. MSC has dedicated teams of specialists experienced in all aspects of cross trades.

INLAND SOLUTIONS

Intermodal Transportation & Haulage Solutions

MSC offers inland transport by road, rail and barge enabling door-to-door delivery and connectivity with global inland commercial centres.

Warehousing & Storage Solutions

Our network of warehouses, adding up to millions of square metres around the globe, means that we can offer a broad range of solutions with door-to-door cargo integrity. We can provide comprehensive pick/pack, de-stuff/palletize, bulk stack, and storage solutions and facilities.

Customs Clearance Solutions

Our customs clearance solutions ensure a smooth and transparent transportation process, minimizing any unnecessary delays or expenses. In addition, many of our global network of agencies are AEO (Authorized Economic Operator) accredited businesses.

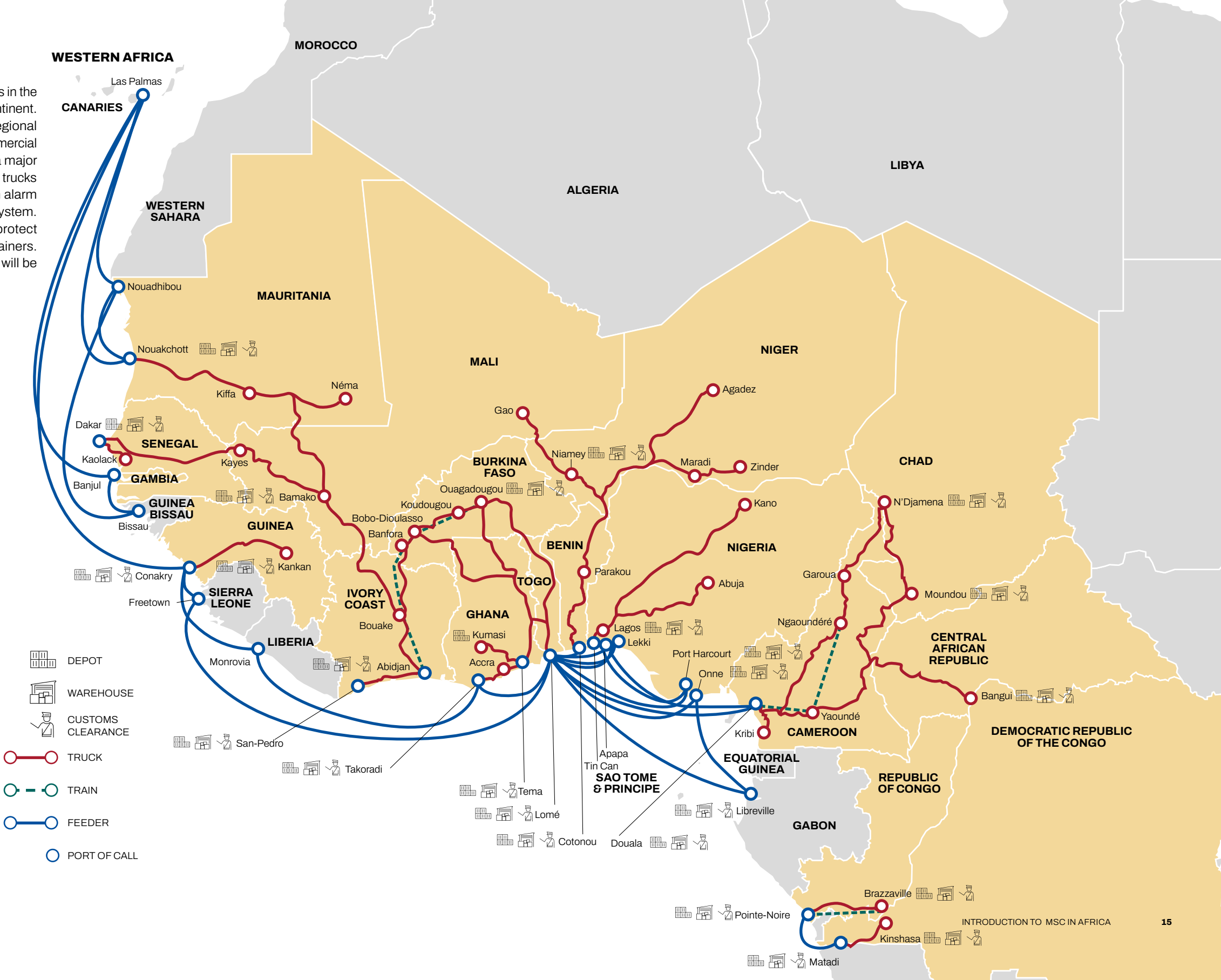

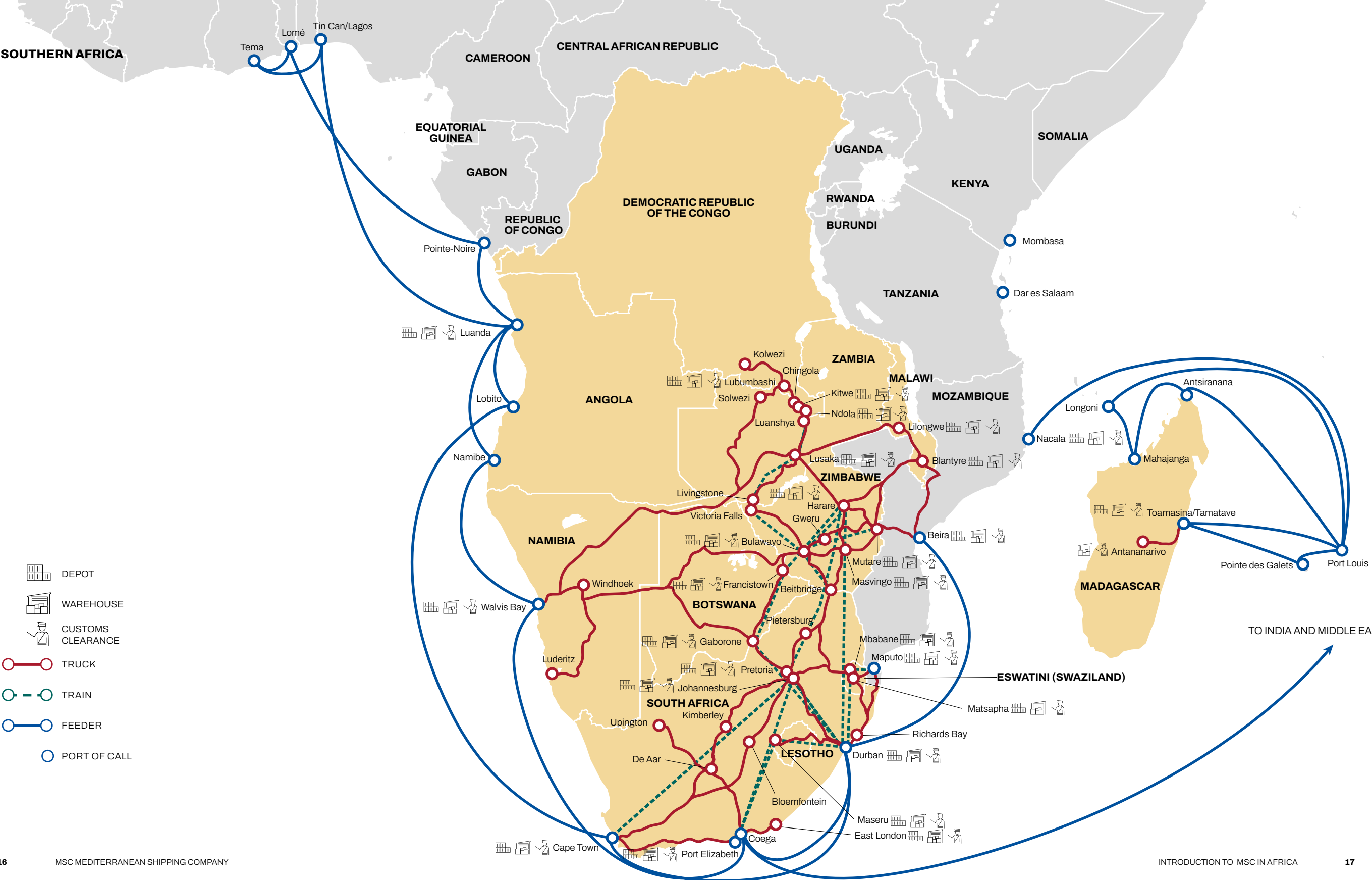

Complementing our global port coverage and regional feeder services, we connect the major inland commercial centres by truck, rail and barge. Cargo safety is a major concern for our customers. At MSC, we equip our trucks with a GPS allowing for real-time localization, an alarm in case of itinerary change and a speed control system. We work with the best security companies to protect our warehouses and monitor the moves of containers. Whatever your cargo, wherever its destination, it will be in safe hands.

With MEDLOG, MSC complements its offering with the following solutions:

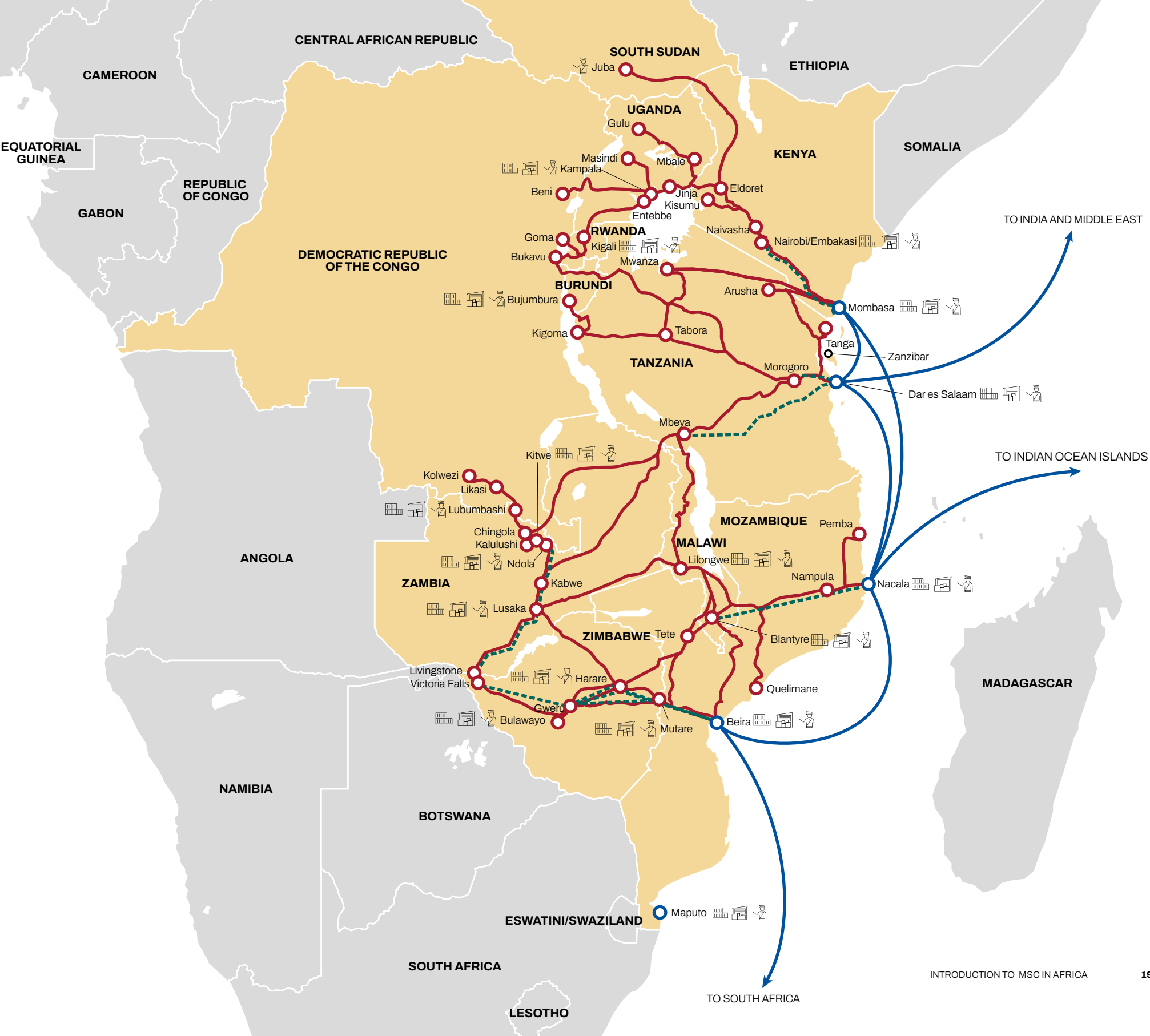

MSC's subsidiary TiL is one of the world's largest and most geographically diverse container terminal operators, handling more than 40 million moves per year.

TiL has a diverse portfolio of container terminals, strategically located at key ports on the world's major shipping routes, providing access to key mature and developing markets.

TiL has a significant presence at some of the world's busiest ports by container volume, including Antwerp, Busan, Long Beach, Los Angeles, New York/New Jersey, Ningbo, Rotterdam, Singapore and Valencia.

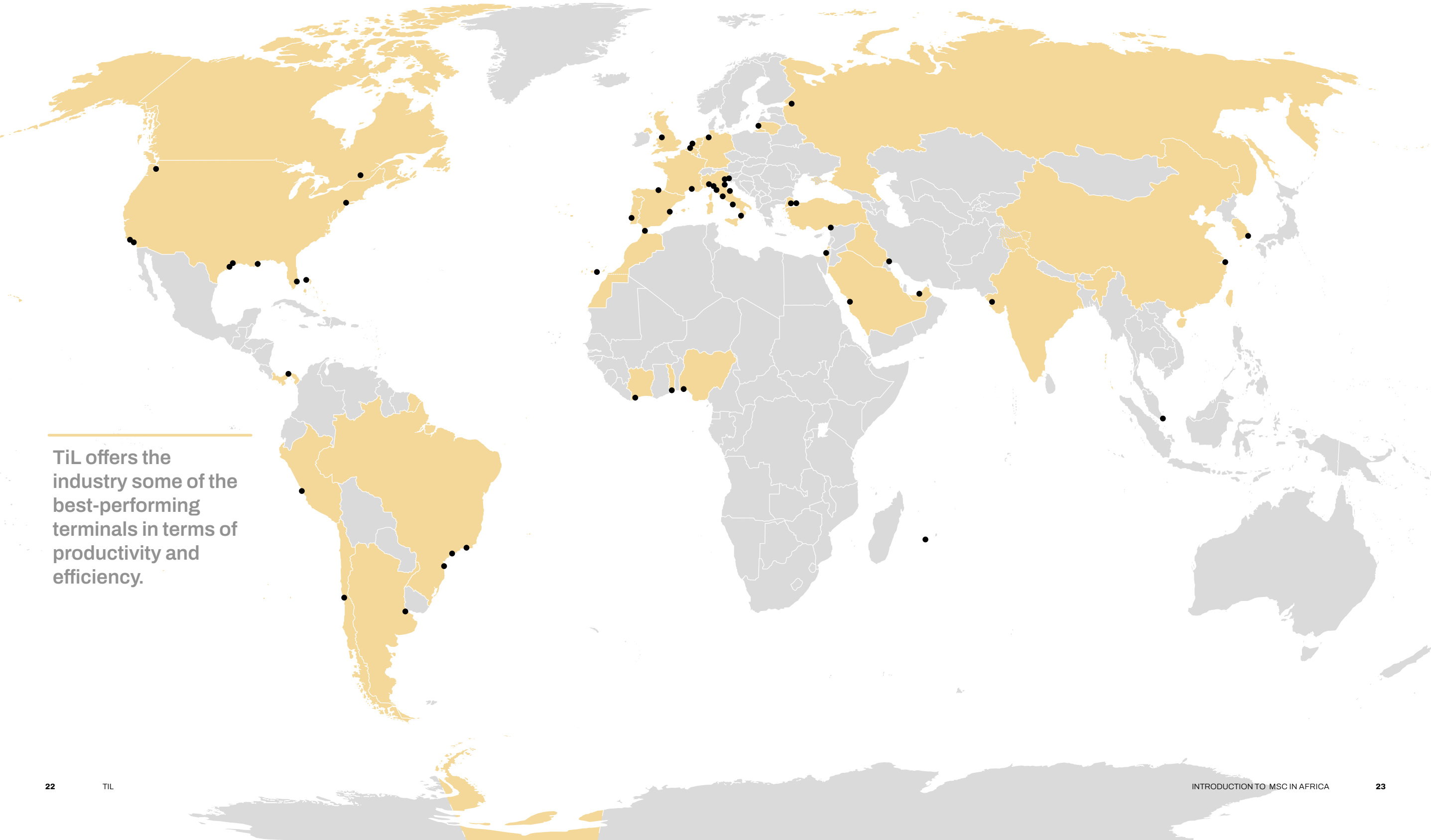
TiL also invests in greenfield terminal development such as the Lomé Container Terminal (LCT). LCT is a deep water port on the West African Coast, with the capacity to welcome 16,000 TEU vessels, and provides transshipment and a gateway to Togo, northern Nigeria and the landlocked countries of Burkina Faso, Mali and Niger. Recent investments such as the expansion of the yard and new equipment were done to bring the terminal's annual capacity to 2.7m TEU/year.

INLAND TRANSPORTATION

Transport solutions by truck/rail/barge

Your cargo is in safe hands with our efficient and reliable multimodal transport solutions by road, rail and barge.

Truck

Wherever you are in the world, our trucking solutions include truck load and unload as well as full truckload (FTL) and less than truckload (LTL) shipments. The safety of your cargo is our priority, so our trucks are equipped with GPS, enabling you to track their position, itinerary and speed in real time.

Rail

Rail transport is cost-effective, safe and environmentally friendly. We are constantly expanding our rail operations and connections between port terminals and inland terminals. We also have several Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) and long-term agreements with state-owned railways. To meet our customers’ needs, we invest in locomotives, wagons and specialized equipment, such as gensets for reefers, swap bodies for general cargo, and tank containers for liquid and gases.

Barge

Save time and costs with our fast, flexible and competitive barge solutions, which connect a growing number of river terminals.

Empty container depots

We have the facilities to store, maintain, repair, clean (normal and biodegradable chemical wash) and upgrade containers (both general purpose and reefers). This enables us to release containers on time and up to specific standards, helping steamship lines to manage their fleets more efficiently. We also support with:

- Garment rack installation/removal
- Flexi-bag installation/removal
- Food grade quality upgrades

Off/on-dock container freight stations (cfs)

Our accessible logistics platforms make it easy to avoid port-area congestion. We handle laden containers and commodities with the highest levels of efficiency and precision. Our solutions include:

- Fully bonded storage facilities
- Customs procedures management
- Container stuffing and devanning
- Pre-stacking and cross-docking operations

Warehousing and distribution

Your goods are safe in our warehouses (bonded and non-bonded), where we store, preserve and hold cargo in a systematic and orderly way.

- Palletization and de-palletization

PORT SOLUTIONS

AGL offers unique expertise in the construction, development, modernization and management of containers, including roll-on/roll-off (RoRo) and inland port terminals in Africa, Asia (Timor) and the USA (Haiti). We provide our customers with the best possible multimodal transport solutions by developing successful public-private partnerships and complying with the highest international standards.

Building a relationship with public partners based on trust is vital to establishing sustainable relationships with port authorities.

SHIPPING SOLUTIONS

AGL's wide range of shipping solutions in Africa includes conventional stevedoring, shipping, dry port management and shipyard facilities. We provide conventional stevedoring services primarily in Africa and Haiti for all types of cargo: bagged, bulk, RoRo, heavy lift, containers and more.

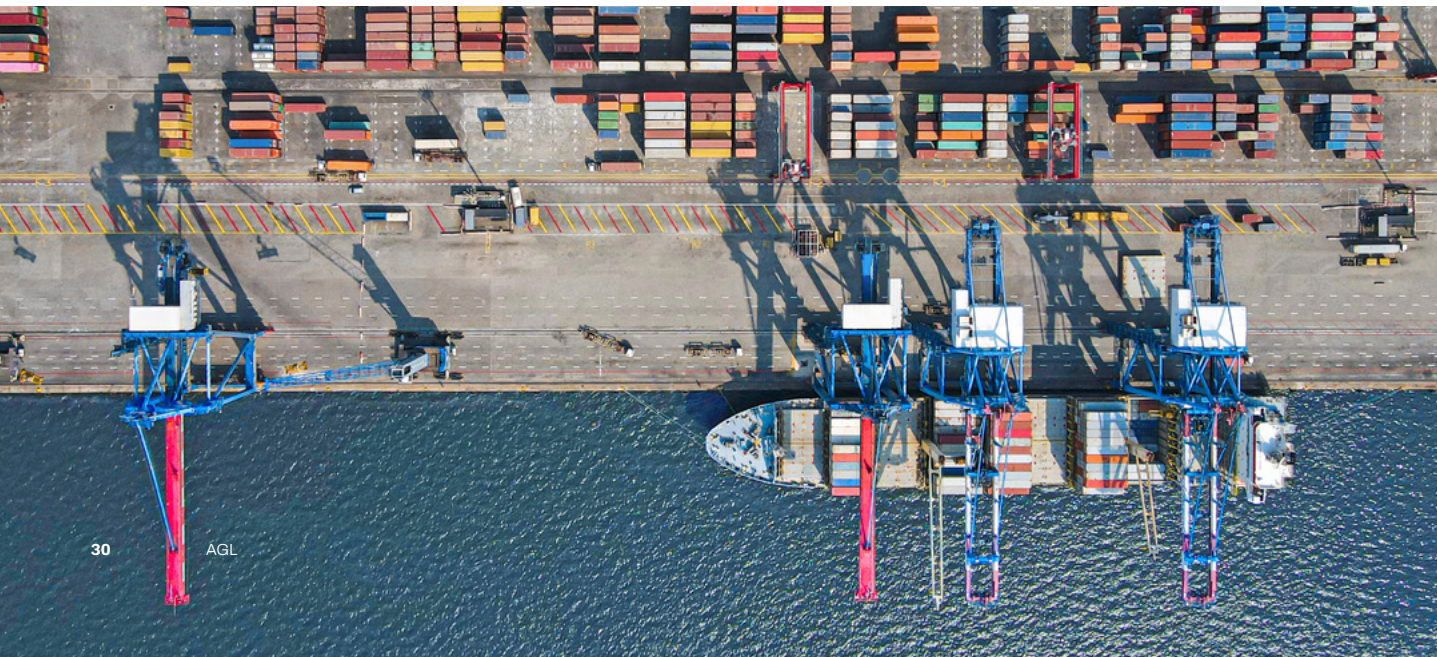
RAILWAYS SOLUTIONS

The railway provides a competitive mode of transport and plays a key role in the development of the countries through which it passes. AGL operates two rail concessions – SITARAIL (between the Ivory Coast and Burkina Faso) and CAMRAIL (in Cameroon) – enabling the smooth multimodal flow of goods and people between neighbouring countries and helping to improve accessibility to inland areas.

We manage and develop commercial multimodal passenger and freight transport services and build, upgrade and modernize rail infrastructure (track, engineering structures and buildings). AGL rail maintenance teams repair locomotives, wagons, specialist machinery and other railway equipment in our international standard workshops.

Both of AGL's rail networks are helping to prevent CO₂ emissions that would otherwise have been produced by road freight each year, thereby considerably reducing total carbon emissions in the countries they serve. Rail freight also helps to alleviate traffic congestion, using dedicated lines which significantly cut wait times for goods leaving ports and cities.

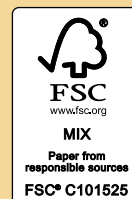
